1. What was the story about? (give a brief outline of the plot but never reveal the ending!)

2. Mention the book's genre.

3. What did you think about the title?



4. Who was the main character and what did they do?

5. Who were the other important characters?

6. Were the characters believable?

7. Who was your favourite and why?



8. Could you relate to any of the characters in the story?

9. Have you ever done or felt some of the things, the characters did?

10. Did you like the book - was it professionally written?

11. Did you have a favourite part of the book?



12. Do you have a least favourite part of the book?

13. Would you change anything in the story?

14. Would you recommend this book to another person? if yes tell us why. If no tell us why.
